

Volunteering at Orion



Orion Elementary School is two distinct programs, Parent Participation and Mandarin Immersion, that form one school. The programs share an administration, PTO and resources. We are fortunate to be a part of a wonderful school community, and are excited to welcome you to it.

As a member of the parent participation program your family is expected to contribute around 8 hours per month to support our school and our students' education and experiences. There are many varied opportunities throughout the year to volunteer, and we are here to support you in finding the options that best suit your skills, interests and availability.

How do I get involved?

To volunteer with the students you will need to be cleared by RCSD. There are 3 levels of clearance, depending on what you will be doing as a volunteer. Complete the volunteer application (and Livescan if needed). You will need a valid California DL/REAL ID and a valid TB test or TB assessment (we can help with this).

Level 1 - Supervised classroom volunteer, no need for Livescan

Level 2 - Occasionally unsupervised, Livescan required

Level 3 - Unsupervised, Livescan required

We have fingerprinting available at Maze Day, Co-op info night and Back to School night. District clearance can take a few weeks at the start of the year.

Returning volunteers: If you have been cleared as a RCSD volunteer, you need to complete the "Returning Volunteer" form on the District website. Livescan clearance remains valid for 5 years before it needs to be undertaken again.

La Escuela Primaria Orion tiene dos programas distintos, Participación de Padres y Inmersión en Mandarín, que forman una sola escuela. Los programas comparten una administración, PTO y recursos. Somos afortunados de ser parte de una maravillosa comunidad escolar y estamos emocionados de darle la bienvenida.

Como miembro del programa de participación de padres, se espera que su familia contribuya alrededor de 8 horas por mes para apoyar nuestra escuela y la educación y las experiencias de nuestros estudiantes. Hay muchas oportunidades variadas durante todo el año para ser voluntario y estamos aquí para ayudar a encontrar las opciones que mejor se adapten a sus habilidades, intereses y disponibilidad.

¿Cómo me involucro?

Para ser voluntario con los estudiantes, deberá obtener la autorización del RCSD. Hay 3 niveles de autorización, dependiendo de lo que harás como voluntario. Complete la solicitud de voluntariado (y Livescan si es necesario). Necesitará una licencia de manejar/identificación REAL de California válida y una prueba o evaluación de tuberculosis válida (podemos ayudarlo con esto).

Nivel 1: voluntario de clase con supervision, sin necesidad de Livescan (Huellas)

Nivel 2: ocasionalmente sin supervisión, se requiere Livescan (Huellas)

Nivel 3: sin supervisión, se requiere Livescan (Huellas)

Tenemos huellas dactilares disponibles el Día del Laberinto, la noche de información cooperativa y la noche de regreso a clases. La autorización del distrito puede tardar algunas semanas a principios de año; tenga paciencia.

Donations are voluntary. We encourage generosity for those that have more, to lift up others to help them succeed in our wonderful school community.


PAYPAL DIRECT DRIVE DONATIONS
